

CALL FOR ENTRIES / OUTDOOR SCULPTURE EXHIBITION May 2016 – April 2018

Project Description

An exhibition of outdoor art will showcase work by contemporary Michigan artists.

Michigan Legacy Art Park (MLAP) has spaces for eight (8) outdoor art/sculptures; five (5) in the Entry Gallery to the Art Park and three (3) on the grounds of Crystal Mountain, an all season resort and conference facility in northwest lower Michigan.

- Each site has a concrete pad (that range in size from 3'x3' to 7'x7') that can be drilled and anchored to. MLAP reserves the right to choose the site where each work will be displayed.
- Each artist will receive a \$500 honorarium.
- MLAP will label the work and will provide publicity for the work and artist.
- Works may be sold during the exhibition but must remain on site (or filled with a suitable replacement) until the exhibition is over. Artist will pay MLAP a 20% commission if artwork is sold during the exhibition.

Selection Criteria

The jury committee is committed to artistic excellence and providing the public with an exhibit that showcases original work created by Michigan artists.

Submissions will be juried on artistic merit, public safety and durability.

Exhibition Timeline

Application due January 22, 2016 Acceptance notification by February 29, 2016 Installation May 1 – 31, 2016
